

Newport House

Newport House uses gas fired hot water boilers to heat the building. The hot water that is produced by the boilers is then circulated through baseboard radiation throughout the building. The temperature of the building is controlled by moving the lever on the thermostat which is located in the hallway of the first floor to the desired setting. Please note that the baseboard can not be blocked by beds, desks, etc. They need airflow for proper heat operation.
