## Rules for Using the

## SATELLITE ACCUMULATION AREA

Each Person using this Satellite Accumulation Area is responsible for observing and following the rules lised below.

- 1) All Hazardous Waste Containers must be located in secondary containment bins.
- 2) Each Hazardous Waste Container must have an approved Hazardous Waste Label attached to the container.
- 3) Each Label must have at least one (1) Hazard checked off.
- 4) The Hazardous Waste Label must have it's header information completed, i.e., Department, Room, etc. by the person attaching the label.
- 5) The contents of each Hazardous Waste Container must be listed with the chemical name on the Hazardous Waste Label. NO symbols are permitted. When you add a waste to the container, you must write it on the label.
- 6) Each Hazardous Waste Container must be tightly capped except when adding waste to the Hazardous Waste Container.
- 7) You may not mix incompatible hazardous wastes in a Hazardous Waste Container.
- 8) If two or more Hazardous Waste Containers have hazardous wastes incompatible with eachother, i.e., one container contains oxidizers and another has reducing agents, they must be placed in separate secondary containment bins in the SAA.
- 9) When a Hazardous Waste Container is full, write the date on the container label and notify your designated Hazardous Waste Representative:
  - -Chemical Hygiene Officer
  - -Environmental Health and Safety Officer/Manager
- 10) All users of this Satellite Accumulation Area must correct any violations of these rules immediately and note the corrections in the attached log.
