#### Instructions

- Visa and/or residency permit fees: This amount should include the cost of reasonable transportation to/from the consulate if you must apply in person, or the cost of batch/group processing if you are using this option through your program.
   (Batch processing is an option only with some program providers where they assist with your visa application.)
- **Program application fee:** Include this fee if applicable; not all programs charge an application fee. Students are responsible for paying application fees up front, and financial aid will include the cost of the application fee for the program you are attending (but not all to which you apply).
- Books: The costs of course materials are included in the tuition allowance, totaling \$288/semester. If program book costs exceed \$288 the excess amount will be factored into your aid.
