INTRODUCTION

Historical Note

Konstantin Kuzminsky a.k.a. KKK was born in Leningrad (now St. Petersburg, Russia) on April 16, 1940 to a family of Russian intellectuals. In 1957, Kuzminsky graduated from a prestigious high school which specialized in teaching all scholarly subjects in English. Later he attended the well-known Tatiana Gnedich workshop on translation. Better known as a poet or performance artist, KKK was one of the first contributors to independent publishing in the U.S.S.R., commonly referred to as “Samizdat”.

In the early 1970s, he became the inspiration for Suzanne Massie’s first anthology of unofficial Soviet poetry, *The Living Mirror: Five Young Poets from Leningrad*. As she recalls, “KKK was extreme, unconventional, controversial, and unforgettable. Excessive in everything: smoking, drinking, talking, he lived always on the edge...”

Later Kuzminsky himself compiled several literary anthologies using his phenomenal memory to reproduce countless poems (*Leprosarium-23*, 1974, *Lepta*, 1975, and others). Even the first book by Joseph Brodsky published in the West, *Short and Long Poems* (Washington D.C. and New York, 1965) was based on the collection of poems compiled by KKK and his lifelong friend Boris Taigin.

However, his monumental work is *The Blue Lagoon: Anthology of Modern Russian Poetry*, published in 1980-1986 by Oriental Research Partners. By that time, however, KKK had managed to immigrate first to Vienna and then to the United States (1978). Russian émigré life in Vienna is humorously and vividly described in his novel *Hotel “Zum Turken.”*

For the first several years, KKK’s life in the States was relatively comfortable since he accepted the position of professor of Russian and English literature at the University of Texas at Austin. This was the time when together with John Bowlt he started a non-profit Institute of Modern Russian Culture at the Blue Lagoon and worked on his 9-volume anthology of contemporary Russian poetry. It took him close to a decade to compile and print this epic publication of text alongside a treasure-trove of visual material. Soon enough, *The Blue Lagoon* became a bibliographic rarity.

In the 1980s and 1990s, Kuzminsky became a very socially active figure in the Russian émigré community. He created an exhibition space in his own apartment in New York, calling it Podval (Basement). There KKK showcased art of others as well as handmade books. His own work was featured in many group exhibitions. However, Kuzminsky’s disregard for traditions, refusal to separate public and private issues, and sometimes provocative actions gained him the reputation of a figure *ad marginem*. On the other hand, the very same status allowed KKK to remain independent and pursue literary and publishing activities he considered to be important. Konstantin Kuzminsky passed away on May 2, 2015 at 75.

History of the Papers and Their Organization

The Konstantin Kuzminsky Papers were purchased by the Amherst Center for Russian Culture in 2014. KKK started collecting archival materials in the late 1950s and systematically expanded his collection until his last days. As Dr. Ilja Kukuj mentioned, “an exceptionally broad range of his interests, variety of art and editorial projects, and numerous contacts with representatives of the Russian intellectual circles both in the U.S.S.R. and in the West, have made Kuzminsky’s archive not only a diversified collection but also a really polyphonic and multimedia text on the Russian culture of the second half of the 20th century.”

The majority of his papers were transferred to the Amherst Center for Russian Culture while KKK was still alive, however, some of the materials were added after his death. Unfortunately, in 2006, a significant portion of KKK’s correspondence with many prominent intellectuals in the West and in the U.S.S.R. was either completely destroyed or water damaged after his upstate New York house was flooded.

After evaluation of his papers, a large portion of KKK collection was vacuum freeze-dried and a smaller part was photocopied and then destroyed. These necessary measures have not violated the integrity of Kuzminsky’s papers which are a unique source for studying Soviet and Russian unofficial culture, literature, and publishing activities of the Russian-speaking community in the United States and Europe.

DESCRIPTION OF THE COLLECTION

Scope and Content Note

The Konstantin Kuzminsky Papers consist of correspondence, publication agreements, subject folders, photographs, samizdat books and journals, newspaper and journal clippings, audio and video materials, catalogs, leaflets, posters, and art which mostly reflect Kuzminsky’s editorial and publishing activities after his immigration to the United States.

A significant part of his collection consists of correspondence (Boxes 1-15) with prominent Russian and Western intellectuals, professional organizations, family and friends, as well as KKK replies to hundreds of letters. Part of his correspondence with his mother and former wives is closed until 2027.

Kuzminsky’s professional activities (Boxes 16-42) reflect the history of the Russian émigré community, Leningrad poetry circles, Samizdat, as well as the history of *The Blue Lagoon Anthology*, the major resource for studying Soviet and Russian unofficial literature. The history of publishing in the Russian Diaspora and Kuzminsky’s own commentaries on many émigré activities are an indispensable source for studying Russian émigré cultural trends.

An artificially created series Subject Folders (Boxes 43-72) will allow one to research in depth the history of unofficial Soviet literature as well as biographies of its representatives.

This collection will be of particular interest to scholars researching underground poetry in the U.S.S.R., as well as Russian émigré intellectual life and editorial activities.
