This is also the anniversary of Armistice Day and the Treaty of Versailles that ended World War I – “The War to End All Wars!” – in 1918, and seems an appropriate time, in 2011, for folks to come together to review several Declarations of Interdependence – one of which, by an Amherst College faculty member, was circulated after 9/11 – and discuss the difference between unity and uniformity, various ways in which the many might become one, and take both another look backwards toward 9/11/2001, and a look forward, too, toward a peaceable kingdom or world without war.
