Chapter: Stage 1-8 (Step 1 and Step 3)

Step 2 will NOT be included in this test, but will be in the Oral Test #2.

Written Test #4 focuses on the **PLAIN FORMS** of all the five aspects in all three types of the Predicates.

Format: Writing only. This test consists of the following three sections.

- (1) Completing the conjugation chart
- (2) Translation
- (3) Kanji recognition

Preparation:

- (1) Memorize the base forms (Plain Imperfective Positives) correctly.
- (2) Review all the conjugation rules for the Plain forms.
- (3) Practice conjugating from the base forms to the other four aspects. Make sure you can also write each form properly.

Kanji:

<Writing>

You are required to use Kanji that you have already learned. No penalty will be given for mistakes on those kanji, but points will be deducted if you did not use those kanji. If you use Kanji that you have not learned yet in class, you should provide 振り仮名 ふりがな to indicate that you know the correct reading. If 振り仮名 ふりがな is not provided, points will be deducted.

<Reading>

You will be asked to read kanji, including ones that you have not yet learned to write but have read in class. To prepare, practice reading 「日記」 にっき in #6 Without 振り仮名 ふりがな (WB, pp.232). You should also understand the meaning of the sentences.
