Chapter: Stage 1-7 (Step 1 and Step 3)
Step 2 of Stage 1-7 will NOT be included in this test. It will be included in the Oral Test #2 scheduled for Thursday, May 5th.

Format: Writing only (No listening or speaking section in this test.)

Kanji: <Writing>

You are expected to use Kanji that you have already learned. No penalty will be given for mistakes on those kanji, but points will be deducted if you did not use those kanji.

If you use Kanji that you have not learned yet in class, you should provide 振り仮名 to indicate that you know the correct reading. If 振り仮名 is not provided, points will be deducted.

<Reading>

You will be asked to read kanji, including ones that you have not yet learned to write but have read in class. To prepare, practice reading the sample questionnaire and the responses in #5 of 3: Discourse Practice (Reading) in Step 3 (WB, pp.211). You should also understand the meaning of the sentences.

- *No reference is allowed.*
- *There are required sections and an optional section in this test, and the optional section is provided only for those who finish the required sections early. **The goal for everyone is to complete the required sections.** The test is designed in that way. Do not think that you have to finish everything including an optional section. As you already know, no points will be deducted even if you do not work on an optional section at all.*
