

Coach G.P. Gromacki



One of the top women's coaches in the country, with a career head coaching record of 344-52, Coach G.P. Gromacki is building a winning tradition at Amherst. Having just finished his sixth year as the Head Women's Basketball Coach at Amherst

College, Gromacki led the Jeffs to another successful season with their fifth consecutive trip to the NCAA DIII Final Four, NESCAC Championship, and finishing with an overall record of 30-3. During his time at Amherst, Gromacki has compiled an overall record of 181-14, leading the Jeffs to their first ever NCAA DIII National Championship during the 2010-2011 season, five NESCAC titles, an NCAA "Sweet 16," five straight NCAA "Final Four" appearances, and has coached 2 WBCA "Players of the Year." Prior to Amherst, Coach Gromacki had an impact on many other programs, coaching his teams to no less than 20 wins in a season.

Gromacki began his Head Coaching career at St. Lawrence University in upstate New York, where he coached the women's basketball program for six seasons. During his time at St. Lawrence, Gromacki took his teams to five NCAA tournament appearances, including a trip the National Championship Game, where he finished as the National Runner Up in 2002 and coached the WBCA Player of the Year. After St. Lawrence, Gromacki became an assistant coach at Temple University under Head Coach Dawn Staley. There he helped guide the program to two Atlantic-10 Championships and two NCAA Tournament appearances. From Temple, Gromacki accepted the Head Coaching position at Hamilton College in Clinton, NY, where he led the team to its first ever 20-win season and first Liberty League Championship and NCAA Tournament appearance in program history. A western Massachusetts native, Gromacki looks to continue to bring his winning tradition home to Amherst.

About the School

The Amherst Basketball School is for girls ages 14-18, who are serious about continuing their basketball careers at the collegiate level. The aim of this three day school is to provide student-athletes with a competitive, fun atmosphere in which they can acquire the feel of basketball at the college level, while at the same time learn more about Amherst College. The school will serve to introduce athletes to drills and instruction that are implemented in college basketball. The school is led by Coach Gromacki and the Amherst Women's Basketball Coaching Staff, along with current players on the women's team. It will also serve to provide student-athletes the opportunity to compete against their peers, while at the same time getting the feel for the campus and what it may be like to attend Amherst College.
