1.1 Marks Overview

1. Seal



The Amherst College identity comprises a system of coordinated graphic marks. These marks can each be used on their own or in approved combinations (see Lockups). Artwork is provided as EPS and PNG files. Always use approved art files from our Visual Identity Toolkit.

EPS files are vector images that can be enlarged and reduced without diminishing image quality. Import EPS files into Word, Excel, InDesign, or other print-based application.

PNG files are bitmap images that can be used in digital media, such as websites or social media. Unlike EPS files, PNGs cannot be enlarged without losing image quality.

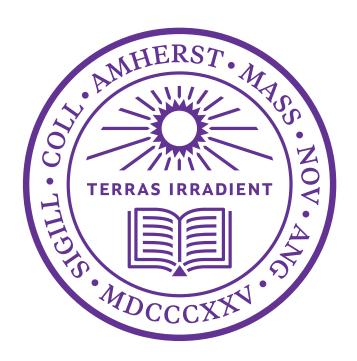

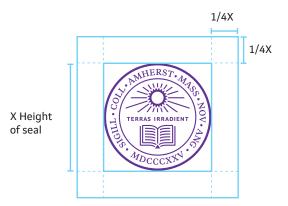


1.2 The Seal

The College seal is the visual imprimatur of Amherst College. It is used in the most formal applications and expressions of the College identity, either as a standalone graphic element or in conjunction with the primary wordmark. This historic seal was updated in 2017 to meet current standards for digital and print applications.

Always use approved art files from our Visual Identity Toolkit, and do not alter the seal.





Clear Space for Print Use 1/4 of the height of the seal is used to create the clear space around the mark. Nothing should be placed in this area.

Small Use in Print



0.3"

The Small Use Seal should be used for print applications between 0.5 inches and 0.3 inches, e.g., a pencil or other small item (please contact commassets@amherst.edu for details). The minimum size for the Small Use Seal is 0.3 inches. The Small Use seal is generally not used in digital applications.

Minimum Size in Print



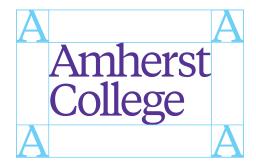
No maximum usage restriction. **Minimum size in print** is 0.5 inches wide.

1.3 Two-Line Wordmark

The two-line wordmark is a unique typographic mark that displays the Amherst name in a left-aligned configuration. It was developed from a modified version of the official College typeface, Tiempos.

Always use approved art files from our Visual Identity Toolkit for College marks and lockups. Do not recreate or alter any College marks or lockups or create new ones.

No maximum usage restriction. Minimum size in print is 0.4 inches wide.

1.4 One-Line Wordmark

The one-line wordmark is a unique typographic mark that displays the Amherst name. It was developed from a modified version of the official College typeface, Tiempos.

Always use approved art files from our Visual Identity Toolkit for College marks and lockups. Do not recreate or alter any College marks or lockups or create new ones.

No maximum usage restriction.

Minimum size in print is 0.75 inches wide.

1.5 The Outlined Monogram & Monogram

The monogram is the "shorthand" identifier for Amherst. The monogram can be used as a stand-alone graphic element. The monogram has been typeset from a modified version of the official College typeface Tiempos.



Outlined Monogram



No maximum usage restriction. Minimum print size for the outlined monogram is 0.3 inches wide.

For print uses **smaller** than 0.3 inches, the monogram should be used.



Monogram



No maximum usage restriction. **Minimum size in print** for the monogram is 0.1 inches.

1.6 The Mammoth (Primary mark)

The mammoth has been designed as the mascot for Amherst College. It can be used for academic or athletic applications as a stand-alone graphic and in approved lockups.





Cropped Mammoth (Secondary mark)



The mammoth should be **centered** on its body when paired with other elements.



Do not center the mammoth on the width of the entire mark. This will result in the mammoth appearing off-center.



No maximum usage restriction. Minimum size in print is 0.5 inches wide. For smaller sizes, use the mammoth head.

1.7 The Mammoth Head

(Secondary mark)

The mammoth head can be used for academic or athletic applications as a stand-alone graphic and in approved lockups.



Minimum Size in Print



0.3"

No maximum usage restriction. **Minimum print size** is 0.3 inches wide.

Small Use in Print

The Small Use Mammoth Head should be used for any applications between 0.3 inches and 0.2 inches. The minimum print size for the Small Use Mammoth Head is 0.2

1.8 Incorrect Usage

Shown here are incorrect uses of Amherst College logos, using the seal as an example. Usage rules apply to all marks and lockups in the identity toolkit.



Don't vertically scale the seal.



Don't horizontally scale the seal.



Don't create additional art for use around the seal. The seal should stand alone or be used in approved lockups.



Don't reproduce the seal in more than one color.



Don't reproduce the seal in an unapproved color.



Don't use the seal at less than 100% opacity. Use approved colors.



Don't rotate the seal.



Don't fill parts of the seal with color. All transparent parts of the seal should show background.



Don't flip the seal.



Don't redraw any parts of the seal.



Don't use different fonts in the seal.

2.1 Overview

Amherst College logos are available in approved combinations, called "lockups." All artwork is provided as EPS and PNG files. Always use approved art files from our Visual Identity Toolkit. Do not create any College lockups outside of our approved lockups.

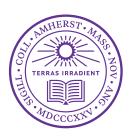

2.4 Centered Lockup

The centered lockup consists of the seal and one-line wordmark in a centered configuration.

Clear Space for Print Use

A square drawn around the A from the wordmark creates the clear space. Nothing should be placed in this area.

Minimum Use



No maximum usage restriction. **Minimum size in print** is 2 inches wide.

Small Use in Print



1.2"

The **Small Use Seal Lockup** should be used for any applications between 2 inches and 1.2 inches. The **minimum** size for the Small Use Seal Lockup is 1.2 inches.

2.5 One-Line Lockup

The one-line lockup consists of the seal and one-line wordmark in a horizontal configuration. Whenever possible, align to left or right rather than centering.

Nothing should be placed in this area.

Minimum Use



3.5"

No maximum usage restriction. **Minimum size in print** is 3.5 inches wide.

Small Use in Print



2.25"

The **Small Use Seal Lockup** should be used for any applications between 3.5 inches and 2.25 inches. The **minimum** size for the Small Use Seal Lockup is 2.25 inches.

2.6 Two-Line Lockup

The two-line lockup consists of the seal and two-line wordmark.





Clear Space for Print Use

A square drawn around the A from the wordmark creates the clear space. Nothing should be placed in this area.

Minimum Use



No maximum usage restriction. **Minimum usage** is 1.6 inches wide.

Small Use in Print



The Small Use Seal Lockup should be used for any applications between 1.6 inches and 1 inch. The minimum size for the Small Use Seal Lockup is 1 inch.

2.7 Monogram Lockup

The monogram lockup consists of the one-line wordmark and the outlined monogram. It is an informal expression of the Amherst identity and can be used in applications where the seal is not appropriate.



Minimum Use



No maximum usage restriction. **Minimum usage** is 1.6 inches wide.

Small Use in Print



The Small Use Monogram Lockup should be used for any applications between 1.6 inches and 0.75 inches. The minimum size for the Small Use Monogram Lockup in print is 0.75 inches.

2.8 One-Line Mammoth Lockup

The mammoth logotype combines the mammoth and College wordmarks. This combination is an expression of the Amherst identity and should be used in applications that don't require the seal.



Minimum Use



3.25"

No maximum usage restriction.

Minimum size in print is 3.25 inches wide.

Small Use in Print



1.75"

The Small Use Mammoth Head Lockup should be used for any applications between 3.25 inches and 1.75 inches. The minimum size for the Small Use Mammoth Head Lockup is 1.75 inches.

2.9 Two-Line Mammoth Lockup

The two-line mammoth logotype combines the mammoth and two-line wordmark. It is an informal expression of the Amherst identity and can be used in applications where the seal is not appropriate.



Minimum Use



No maximum usage restriction. **Minimum size in print** is 1.2 inches wide.

Small Use in Print



The Small Use Mammoth Head Lockup should be used for any applications between 1.2 inches and 0.75 inches. The minimum size for the Small Use Mammoth Head Lockup is 0.75 inches.

2.10 Centered Mammoth Lockup

The centered mammoth lockup combines the mammoth and oneline wordmarks. It is an informal expression of the Amherst identity and can be used in applications where the seal is not appropriate.



Minimum Use



No maximum usage restriction. **Minimum size in print** is 1.4 inches wide.

Small Use in Print



The Small Use Mammoth Head Lockup should be used for any applications between 1.4 inches and 0.75 inches. The minimum size for the Small Use Mammoth Head Lockup is 0.75 inches.

2.11 Formal Departmental Lockup

The formal departmental lockup consists of the College seal, the College wordmark and the academic or administrative unit descriptor.







Clear Space for Print Use

A square drawn around the A from the wordmark creates the clear space. Nothing should be placed in this area. The clear space rule can be used to create a **background** for the lockup. Minimum usage rules still apply.

Minimum Use



No maximum usage restriction. Minimum size in print is 0.5 inches wide at the seal as shown above.

Small Use in Print



0.3"

The Small Use Seal Lockup should be used for any applications between 0.5 inches and 0.3 inches measured at the seal. The minimum size for the Small Use Seal Lockup is 0.3 inches measured at the seal.

2.12 Formal Departmental Lockup Format

The **seal** is the total height of mark.



A one-line department or center is shown above. The department name is set in Setimo Regular.

The Amherst College wordmark is used in this lockup.

The **seal** is the height of the first two lines of text.



A **two-line** department or center is shown above. The department name is set in Setimo Regular.

The **Amherst College wordmark** is used in this lockup.

2.13 Informal Departmental Lockup

The informal departmental lockup consists of the College wordmark and the academic or administrative unit descriptor.

"Department of" is optional.



Clear Space in Print Use

A square drawn around a capital letter from the department name creates the clear space. Nothing should be placed in this area.



The clear-space rule can be used to create a **background** for the lockup. Minimum usage rules apply.

Minimum Use



No maximum usage restriction.

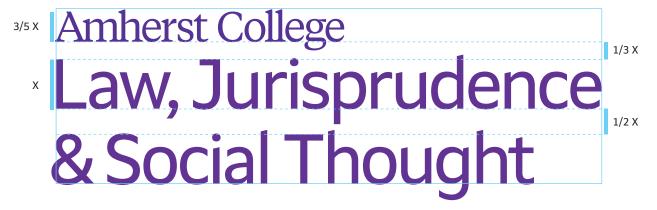
Minimum size in print is 0.75 inches at the Amherst wordmark as shown above.

2.14 Informal Departmental Lockup Format



A **one-line** department or center is shown above. The department name is set in Setimo Regular.

The Amherst College wordmark is used in this lockup.



A **two-line** department or center is shown above. The department name is set in Setimo Regular. The **Amherst College wordmark** is used in this lockup.

2.15 Informal Departmental Lockup

The informal department and center logotype consists of the outlined monogram and the academic or administrative unit descriptor.



"Department of" is optional.

An ampersand should be used in place of the word "and."



Clear Space in Print Use
A square drawn around the A from the wordmark creates the clear space. Nothing should be placed in this area.



The clear-space rule can be used to create a background for the lockup. Minimum usage rules apply.

Minimum Use



Department of Physics & Astronomy

No maximum usage restriction.

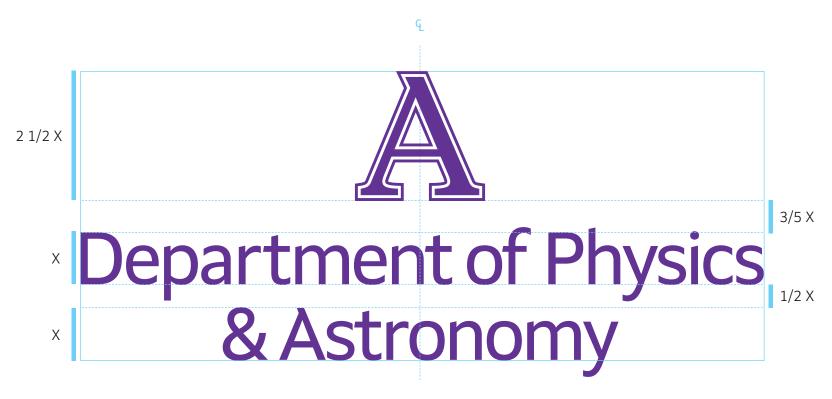
Minimum size in print is 0.4 inches wide from the left side of the monogram to the right as shown above.

Small Use in Print



The **Small Use Monogram Lockup** should be used for any applications between 0.4 inches and 0.2 inches measured at the monogram. The **minimum** size for the Small Use Monogram Lockup is 0.2 inches measured at the monogram.

2.16 Informal Departmental Lockup Format



The department name should be typeset in **Setimo Regular**.

2.17 Incorrect Uses

The academic and administrative unit logotypes, exemplified here by Amherst College Department of Physics & Astronomy, should not be altered in any way, including extending, condensing, outlining; adding borders, special effects or drop shadows; or attaching other icons. The graphics on this page illustrate a few examples of incorrect usage.



Don't place the sub-unit descriptor above the monogram and school name.



Don't align flush right.



Don't rearrange components within lockup.



Don't use a format not meant for your organization.



Don't string the sub-unit descriptor in one long line. Break it so that the longest line is slightly longer than the academic unit name.



Don't use unapproved weights or cases for the sub-unit descriptor.



Don't use unapproved colors.



Don't place the logotype on top of a busy or complex photograph.



Don't create a background shape for the lockups that does not follow the clear-space rules.

2.17 Incorrect Uses, Cont'd

The academic and administrative unit logotypes, exemplified here by Amherst College Department of Physics & Astronomy, should not be altered in any way, including extending, condensing, outlining; adding borders, special effects or drop shadows; or attaching other icons. The graphics on this page illustrate a few examples of incorrect usage.



Don't use unapproved typefaces.



Don't stretch the lockups.



Don't add a stroke.Don't use unapproved colors.



Don't change the size relationships of elements within the lockups.



Don't use the small-use lockups at an unapproved size. **Don't** crop the lockups.



Don't use type from the informal lockup with the seal.

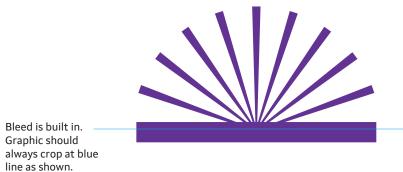

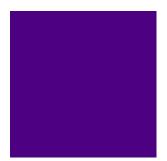
4.1 Primary Color Palette

Mammoth Purple is the main color in the Amherst College Identity.

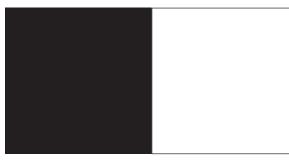

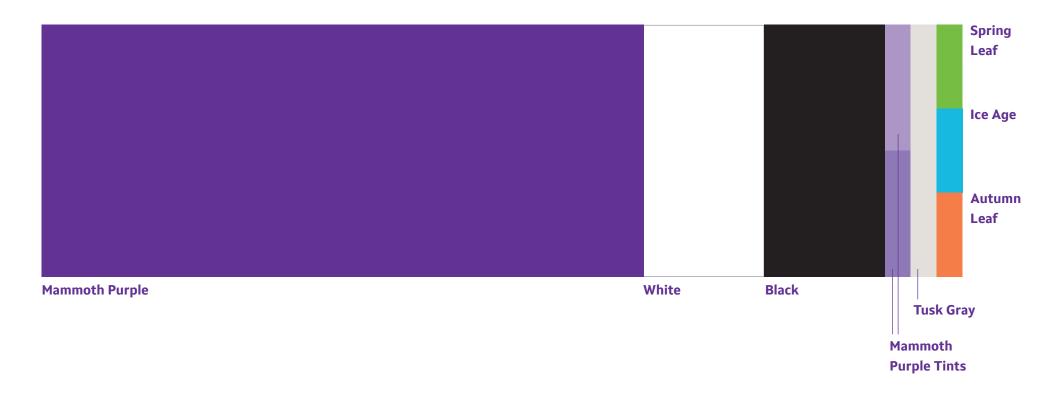
4.2 Secondary Color Palette

Secondary colors may be used in small proportions. Avoid using the secondary colors in a manner that suggests that the Amherst College school colors are anything other than purple and white.



4.3 Entire Color Palette

Recommended ratio of use:



Mammoth Purple should be used more than any other color in the palette. The secondary colors are meant to act as complements to the main color palette.

4.4 Approved One-Color Combinations



White on Mammoth Purple



Mammoth Purple on white



White on Mammoth Purple Light



Black on white



Black on Mammoth Purple Pale



White on black



Mammoth Purple Light on white.



Do not use Mammoth Purple on black. The contrast is not high enough for adequate legibility.



Do not use Mammoth Purple Pale on white.

Amherst's official serif typeface is Tiempos. This typeface offers a wide range of weights, allowing for small and digital use without degradation. Consistent use of this official typeface helps reinforce Amherst's identity.

5.3 Secondary Official Typeface

Amherst's official sans typeface is Setimo. This typeface offers a wide range of weights, allowing for small and digital use without degradation. It acts as a complement to Tiempos. Consistent use of this official typeface helps reinforce the College's identity.

Note that Setimo by default has wide letter tracking, which works well for small type. For headlines and other large type, tighten the tracking.
