The Amherst College Museums Summer Internship Program provides an immersive experience for students exploring a career in museums. The Emily Dickinson Museum, the Mead Art Museum and the Beneski Museum of Natural History will jointly award a limited number of internships, with preference given to students in the classes of 2024 and 2025. The internship is open to all students who are curious about museum work, with no previous experience required. Application deadline is March 1.

Summer internships & Job opportunities

The Orleans Conservation Trust (OCT) is hiring a summer intern. OCT is a non-profit land trust that has been protecting land in Orleans, MA for over 50 years. Our interns work side-by-side with staff and community leaders on land stewardship initiatives. OCT interns gain valuable professional experience and develop a passion to save open spaces. The intern will assist with land management needs and report to OCT's Director of Land Stewardship. The intern can expect to be involved with property inspections and maintenance, long and short-term land management planning, habitat management, property documentation, and volunteer engagement. OCT's summer internship program, now in its tenth year, is a terrific opportunity to get experience working for an environmental nonprofit and to build an understanding of land conservation.
